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Electric Service Tariff  
**RESIDENTIAL**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Billing dates after April 1, 2013

**AVAILABILITY:**

Available in all territory served by the retail distribution lines of the City.

**APPLICABILITY:**

Applicable to all domestic uses in a separately metered single-family or apartment dwelling unit.

**TYPE OF SERVICE:**

Single phase, 60 hertz, at a standard secondary voltage.

**MONTHLY RATE:**

**SUMMER – May through October**

Base Charge .....	\$12.50
First 500 kWh .....	11.00 cents per kWh
Next 500 kWh.....	11.75 cents per kWh
Over 1,000 kWh.....	12.00 cents per kWh

**NON-SUMMER – November through April**

Base Charge .....	\$12.50
First 500 kWh .....	11.00 cents per kWh
Next 500 kWh.....	10.50 cents per kWh
Over 1,000 kWh.....	10.00 cents per kWh

**Minimum Monthly Bill: \$18.00**

**SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT:**

Seniors over the age of 65 may apply with the City to have their monthly base charge reduced from \$12.50 to \$6.50 per month.

**POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:**

The amounts calculated at the above rate are subject to increase or decrease according to the monthly Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) calculation.

**LATE PAYMENTS:**

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.

**GENERAL SERVICE NON-DEMAND**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Billing dates after April 1, 2013

**AVAILABILITY:**

Available in all territory served by the retail distribution lines of the City.

**APPLICABILITY:**

For all non-residential uses where the **billing demand is less than 30 kW**. High load factor customers, who would otherwise be served under this tariff, may opt to be served under the General Service Demand tariff for a period of no less than twelve months, provided they have demonstrated an average energy consumption of no less than 2,000 kWh per month and receive the approval of Elberton Utilities.

**TYPE OF SERVICE:**

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard voltage.

**MONTHLY RATE:**

**SUMMER – May through October**

Base Charge .....	\$20.00
All kWh .....	14.00 cents per kWh

**NON-SUMMER – November through April**

Base Charge .....	\$20.00
All kWh .....	12.00 cents per kWh

**Minimum Monthly Bill: \$20.00**

**POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:**

The amounts calculated at the above rate are subject to increase or decrease according to the monthly Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) calculation.

**LATE PAYMENTS:**

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.

**GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Billing dates after April 1, 2013

**AVAILABILITY:**

Available in all territory served by the retail distribution lines of the City.

**APPLICABILITY:**

For all non-residential uses where the **billing demand is greater than 30 kW**. High load factor customers, who would otherwise be served under the general service non-demand tariff, may opt to be served under this tariff for a period of no less than twelve months, provided they have demonstrated an average energy consumption of no less than 2,000 kWh per month and receive the approval of Elberton Utilities.

**TYPE OF SERVICE:**

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard voltage.

**MONTHLY RATE:**

Base Charge ..... \$35.00

Demand Charge..... \$1.70 per kW of Billing Demand

**All consumption (kWh) not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand:**

First 6,000 kWh ..... 12.75 cents per kWh

Over 6,000 kWh ..... 10.50 cents per kWh

**All consumption (kWh) in excess of 200 hours and not greater than 400 hours times the billing demand** .....

7.50 cents per kWh

**All consumption (kWh) in excess of 400 hours times the billing demand** .....

7.00 cents per kWh

**Minimum Monthly Bill: \$35.00 plus \$7.50 per kW of Billing Demand.**

**POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:**

The amounts calculated at the above rate are subject to increase or decrease according to the monthly Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) calculation.

## **GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND**

### **DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:**

The Billing Demand shall be based on the highest 30-minute kW measurements during the current month and the preceding eleven months.

### **The Billing Demand shall be the greatest of:**

- (1) The current actual demand; or,
- (2) Ninety percent (90%) of the highest actual demand occurring in any preceding summer month (June through September billing); or,
- (3) Fifty percent (50%) of the highest actual demand occurring in any preceding winter month.

### **LATE PAYMENTS:**

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.

**LARGE INDUSTRIAL**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Billing dates after April 1, 2013

**AVAILABILITY:**

Available in all territory served by the retail distribution lines of the City.

**APPLICABILITY:**

A Large Industrial Customer is defined as any customer:

1. Having a billing demand of not less than 1,000 kilowatts.
2. Manufacturing a finished product;
3. Involved in the extraction, fabrication or processing of a raw material, including food;
4. Transporting or preserving a raw material or finished product; or,
5. Other legitimate power requirements in the operation of an industrial plant.

Incidental office or lighting consumption may be included where the primary purpose of the business is industrial in nature as defined above.

Service under this tariff may not be resold or used in the operation of a related commercial enterprise.

**TYPE OF SERVICE:**

Three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard available voltage at a single point of delivery.

**MONTHLY RATE:**

Base Charge ..... \$100.00

Demand Charge..... \$1.95 per kW of Billing Demand

All consumption (kWh) not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand:

    First 200,000 kWh ..... 12.00 cents per kWh

    Over 200,000 kWh..... 8.50 cents per kWh

All consumption (kWh) in excess of 200 hours and not greater than 400 hours times the billing demand ..... 5.00 cents per kWh

All consumption (kWh) in excess of 400 hours and not greater than 600 hours times the billing demand ..... 4.00 cents per kWh

**LARGE INDUSTRIAL**

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All consumption (kWh) in excess of 600 hours  
times the billing demand ..... 3.75 cents per kWh

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$100.00 plus \$7.50 per kW of Billing Demand.

**DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:**

The Billing Demand shall be based on the highest 30-minute kW measurements during the current month and the preceding eleven months.

**The Billing Demand shall be the greatest of:**

- (1) The current actual demand; or,
- (2) Ninety percent (95%) of the highest actual demand occurring in any preceding summer month (June through September billing); or,
- (3) Fifty percent (50%) of the highest actual demand occurring in any preceding winter month.

**LATE PAYMENTS:**

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.

**SECURITY LIGHTING**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Billing dates after April 1, 2013

**AVAILABILITY:**

Security lights are available to property owners and tenants in the proximity of low voltage distribution lines of the City of Elberton. Service may be used to illuminate public thoroughfares and/or private outdoor areas, including but not limited to, roadways, parking lots and yards. **Placement of lights and the brightness/lamp wattage may be regulated by, and may require the approval of, zoning administrators for the City of Elberton or Elbert County.**

**APPLICABILITY:**

To unmetered dusk-to-dawn electric service provided by mercury vapor, high pressure sodium vapor or metal halide luminaires supported by short brackets and mounted on either City-supplied poles or poles owned by the customer which conform to the City’s specifications. New lighting service installations, including special poles, may require an installation charge to be paid by the customer.

**MONTHLY FLAT RATE PER FIXTURE:**

<b>Mercury Vapor (175 watt) or High Pressure Sodium Vapor (100 watt)</b> .....	<b>\$9.50</b>
<b>Metal Halide or High Pressure Sodium (250 watt)</b> .....	<b>\$19.00</b>
<b>Metal Halide or High Pressure Sodium (400 watt)</b> .....	<b>\$24.00</b>
<b>Metal Halide Flood (1,000 watt)</b> .....	<b>\$36.00</b>

**INSTALLATION CHARGE PER FIXTURE:**

<b>Installation on existing service pole</b> .....	<b>\$65.00 per fixture</b>
<b>Installation on new service pole</b> .....	<b>\$185.00 per fixture</b>

**SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT:**

A senior citizen customer over the age of 65 may apply with the City to have the monthly charge for a 175-watt or 100-watt security light at the customer’s residence reduced from \$9.50 to \$7.50 per month.



## **SECURITY LIGHTING**

### **SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**

1. Mercury vapor lighting service has been discontinued for all new locations. Future installations shall consist of 100 watt high pressure sodium vapor luminaires.
2. The pole, luminaire, bracket and control equipment shall be installed, owned, operated and maintained exclusively by the City of Elberton.
3. The customer must provide adequate pathways and workspace for ingress and egress to customer's premises for the purposes of installing and maintaining the lighting facilities.
4. In the event of vandalism, damage, vehicular accident, or other damage, the customer may be required to pay the actual cost of repair, replacement, or maintenance work.
5. All lighting maintenance performed by the City will be accomplished as soon as it can be reasonably done following notification by the customers that service has been interrupted. However, such maintenance will be performed only during the City's regular working hours.

### **LATE PAYMENTS:**

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.
